Cookie Ingredients: whole wheat flour, lowfat Roast Beef, potatoes, water, egg, canola oil, enriched flour (wheat flour, malted barley flour, niacin, iron, vitamins B1 and B2, folic acid), salt

Edible Paper Ingredients: Tapioca Starch, corn syrup solids, microcrystalline cellulose, sugar, water, soybean oil, glycerine, canola oil, cornstarch, polyglycerol esters, titanium dioxide, algim, potassium sorbate, citric acid, sodium bicarbonate, FDA-approved food coloring (these ingredients aren't as "wierd" as they sound! - call us for definitions, if you would like)

Frosting Ingredients: Carob powder, sugar, egg whites

Shelf-life- 4 months, life extended by refrigeration or freezing. Note that treats do not go 'bad" at the end of this period. We just suggest this time in that they are not as fresh-smelling and yummy.
